

Rules of the Round The World Ideal Trip *Contest* – April 2014

Article 1: ORGANIZER

SkyTeam Airline Alliance Management Cooperative U.A., a Dutch cooperation, registered with the Trade Register in Amsterdam under number 34345101, having its corporate seat in Amsterdam, The Netherlands, and its place of business at Schiphol Boulevard 367, WTC, 1118 BJ Schiphol, The Netherlands (“SkyTeam”) is organizing a free contest with no obligation to purchase on the Round The World Ideal Trip tab within its Facebook SkyTeam page, to run from April 1st 2014 at 7:00 pm, Paris (France) time, to April 30th 2014 at 11:00 pm Paris (France) time (the “**Contest**”). Entries submitted after this time will not be considered. This contest is to create awareness and promote the ability to buy with SkyTeam a Round The World ticket.

Article 2: PARTICIPATION

The Contest is open to any natural person aged 21 or over. A participant can only win once. Entry is free of charge and with no obligation to purchase, and is open only to members of the Facebook social networking service (facebook.com) having a personal Facebook account. Neither person who contributes to organizing and running the Contest, nor any staff employed by the SkyTeam office, SkyTeam member airlines and their affiliates as well as members of their immediate family may enter the Contest.

Entrants must have access to an internet connection, a valid e-mail address, and a Facebook user account to enter the Contest.

By entering the Contest, you accept the terms, conditions and provisions of the present Contest rules as well as the ethical rules governing the Internet and all legislation and regulations pertaining to free Contests. Non-compliance with the entry conditions set out in the present Rules will render an entry null and void.

This Contest and its rules are written in English only. Consequently, participants must have good knowledge of this language to be able to play and win the contest prize.

Article 3: CONTEST ANNOUNCEMENT

The present Contest is announced on the SkyTeam Facebook page (www.facebook.com/skyteam) through messages posted on the message and conversation Wall.

The Contest is also announced on the SkyTeam’s website (skyteam.com). The Contest may also be announced in e-newsletters by SkyTeam or airline companies members of SkyTeam.

The Contest may also be announced in other advertising media including, but not limited to, banner advertisements on the websites of SkyTeam and its members or partners.

Article 4: PRINCIPLE OF THE CONTEST

The participant must first have registered on the facebook.com page / SkyTeam by clicking on "like". The participant must authorize the Facebook application "Round the world Ideal Trip" to access their FB personal basic information and is invited to plan his ideal trip with the application. The participant may create several times his/her ideal trip and share it on his/her Facebook page. The participant is invited to choose a National Geographic Expedition. The participant is then asked to register to the contest for a chance to win the prize. The participant can only register once on the online registration SkyTeam contest form.

Article 5: DESIGNATION OF THE WINNER

At the end of the contest SkyTeam office, will hold a sweepstake. This will be a random drawing taking into account all eligible entries received during the applicable entry period as described on article 1.

The winner will be identified and informed within 3 weeks after the end of the game.

The winner will be informed that he/she has won by e-mail via his/her email address and his/her name may be published on the SkyTeam's website and /or the SkyTeam Facebook page.

If the winner does not respond within fifteen days to the mail, he or she shall be deemed to have forfeited the prize, which will then be reassigned through another sweepstake organized by SkyTeam.

The winner, on receiving notification of his/her win, must inform SkyTeam of all the personal details required to organize his/her Round the World Trip and National Geographic Expedition (Name and first name, telephone number, email addresses, postal address, passport number, visa).

The winner shall comply with the present rules. Should it transpire that the winner does not meet the criteria of the present rules, his/her prize will not be awarded and shall be reassigned through another sweepstake organized by SkyTeam.

Prize may under no circumstances be taken back or exchanged for their cash value or any other prize, nor be transferred to a third party. However, in cases of force majeure or if circumstances so require, SkyTeam may substitute different prizes of equivalent value for the prizes initially proposed. Prize shall not be open to challenge or any other demand of any kind whatsoever. Winner of the prize shall not hold SkyTeam liable with respect to the prizes and notably their condition and qualities.

Article 6: CHANGES TO THE TERMS & CONDITIONS

SkyTeam reserves the right to change the terms, conditions and/or legal mentions of the contest guidelines at any time and without prior warning. Users are therefore advised to regularly check the latest version of the official Rules available on the Round the World Facebook tab.

Article 7: THE PRIZE

1 Round the World Ticket for 1 person, for up to 26.000 miles
+ 1 credit toward a National Geographic Expedition for 1 person, worth up to 5,000€

Round the World Ticket:

- 1 free ticket for 1 person for up to 26.000 miles in Economy Class
- Contest winner will be directly in contact with a person from SkyTeam to plan his/her Round the World trip and confirm booking.
- Contest winner is required to select his/her round the world trip within 3 months of the prize announcement.
- Round The world ticket is valid for travel for 12 months
- Carriers: Aeroflot, Aerolíneas Argentinas, Aeromexico, Air Europa, Air France, Alitalia, China Airlines, China Eastern Airlines, China Southern Airlines, CSA Czech Airlines, Delta Air Lines, Garuda Indonesia, Kenya Airways, KLM Royal Dutch Airlines, Korean Air, Middle East Airlines, Saudia, Tarom, Shanghai Airlines (affiliate), Vietnam Airlines and Xiamen Airlines.
Codeshares on non-SkyTeam carriers not permitted

- **Routing:**

Travel must begin and end in the same country.

Travel must include at least (but not more than): one transatlantic flight, one transpacific flight, one flight between area 2 and area 3.

Number of segments: max 4.

- **Reservations:**

Reservations required for all flights prior to departure.

7 days for the 1st intercontinental flight only. Ticketing must be done within 72 hours after booking and at least 7 days before departure whichever is earlier.

Min. stay / Max. stay: Between 10 days and 1 year

Stopover: Min. 3 required / Max. 5 permitted

Class of service: Economy

- **Pass combinability:**

All other SkyTeam Regional Go Passes may be issued in connection with the Go Round the World Pass (at own cost).

- **Baggage allowance:** Economy 1PC (max 23kgs each)

Credit toward a National Geographic Expedition: The prize includes a credit worth up to 5,000€ to be used against a National Geographic Expedition for 1 person. Any amount due over the value of the credit is solely winner's responsibility. Winner will not receive any difference in value if selected trip value is less than value of voucher.

- Trips are as described at the online catalog available at <http://www.nationalgeographicexpeditions.com/>.

- Dates of travel relate to travel originating from and returning to the United States.
- Winner must book trip within 3 months of prize announcement. If trip is not booked after that time, trip credit may be forfeited.
- Trips are subject to availability at the time of booking. Trip specifics are subject to availability.
- Winner must travel within 18 months of prize announcement. All travel must be complete by November 30, 2015 or trip credit may be forfeited.
- Airfare is not included in trip price for any National Geographic Expeditions.
- Trips are conducted in English only and contest winners would need to be comfortable communicating in English to travel on the National Geographic Expedition.
- Winner agrees to accept National Geographic Expeditions terms and conditions for the trip.

All expenses and incidental travel costs not expressly stated in the package description above, including but not limited to, ground transportation; meals; incidentals; gratuities; passenger tariffs or duties; airline fees; surcharges; airport fees; service charges or facility charges; personal charges such as alcoholic beverages, spa services, and internet usage; security fees; taxes or other expenses are the responsibility solely of winner. The prize will not give rise to any compensation in any form whatsoever (repayment of the unit value of the ticket in cash).

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Article 8: NOTIFICATION OF WINNERS

The winner authorizes SkyTeam to use his/her name, first name, photograph or Ideal Trip testimonial "tip" on the SkyTeam's website and on the SkyTeam Facebook page and for the purposes of communication or advertising pertaining to the present Contest and on any publishing media with no financial contribution being claimable by winners in this connection.

Article 9: CONTEST DATES

SkyTeam will not be held responsible if, in a case of force majeure or events beyond its control, it is forced to cancel the present Contest, shorten or prolong it, defer it, or modify its conditions.

Article 10: CHECKS ON ENTRANT IDENTITY

Contest Entrants shall authorize any and all checks on their identity and departure city. These checks shall be carried out in strict compliance with legal provisions concerning the right to privacy. Any indication of falsified, fraudulent, false, untrue, incorrect or inexact identity or address details shall render an entry null and void.

Article 11: LIABILITY

SkyTeam shall not be held liable in the event of any Internet dysfunction preventing access to the Contest or its normal operation. In particular, SkyTeam shall not be held liable for any external malicious acts.

While SkyTeam shall make every effort to offer users information and/or tools that are available and verified, it shall nevertheless not be liable for any errors (notably display errors on Contest sites and erroneous e-mails), nor for any lack of data availability and/or the presence of computer viruses on the Contest website. Submitting an entry to the Contest constitutes your acceptance of the characteristics and limitations of the Internet, the lack of protection for certain items of data against any misuse or hacking, and the threat of contamination by any computer viruses circulating on the Internet. It is the responsibility of each Entrant to take all appropriate measures to protect their own data and/or software stored on their computer and telephone equipment against any attack.

Prospective Contest Entrants log on to the Contest website at their own risk.

Furthermore, SkyTeam shall not be held responsible for:

- Problems with telephone connections,
- Software or hardware problems,
- The destruction of data supplied by participants for reasons not attributable to SkyTeam,
- Human errors or errors of electrical origin,
- Disruption that may affect the proper running of the Contest or dysfunctions in the automated prize draw process.
- Problems linked to the transportation & delivery of the reward

SkyTeam shall not be held responsible for the consequences of any delays in the delivery of electronic mail that cannot be attributed to it. Any and all complaints must be made directly by recipients to the companies responsible for the transmission of such electronic mail.

SkyTeam shall not be liable for any physical inability on the part of winners to board an aircraft or travel to a foreign country if their travel documents are not in order (lack of visa, lack of passport, passport expired, etc.).

In all cases, if the proper administrative and/or technical operation of the Contest is disrupted by a cause beyond the control of SkyTeam, the said SkyTeam reserves the right to terminate the Contest early.

SkyTeam may verify the identity of the participants by all means needed at any time.

SkyTeam has the right to cancel the whole Round the World Idea Trip Contest, if any sort of fraud is detected.

If a fraud is detected, SkyTeam has the right to exclude the participant from the Contest, without attributing him/her a reward. In that case, the participant may also be denounced to the competent authority.

SkyTeam shall not be held responsible by the participants, in case of exclusion following the detection of potential frauds.

A fraud is considered as, but not limited to:

- Entering the Contest with fake name, surname
- Using multiple email addresses and/or Facebook accounts to create multiple registration entries
- Using any technical ways to generate fake accounts

Any fraud or non-compliance in connection with the present Contest Rules may result in the Entrant's expulsion from the Contest, SkyTeam reserving the right, where appropriate, to initiate legal proceedings against the Entrant.

Article 12: REFUNDS

Entrants who access the site from a modem or a dial-up line invoiced on a pro rata basis according to connection time or per call can obtain a refund of their connection costs on the basis of one fixed-price refund per day corresponding to the cost, including tax, of a local fixed-line call lasting six (6) minutes. The expenses so incurred (second class postage stamp at current rate) will be refunded on request. One request only per Entrant (same name, same address and/or same email address and/or same bank account details) will be taken into account for the duration of the Contest.

It being noted that in the current state of service or technical offers, some Internet Service Providers offer free or fixed-price connections to users, it is hereby expressly agreed that any access to the Contest Website made on the basis of free or fixed-price usage (notably via cable, ADSL or special line) shall not be refunded in so far as the subscription to the services provided by the Internet Service Provider is in such cases contracted by the user for their general web usage and also in so far as the user incurs no cost or additional disbursement.

Similarly, it is imperative to submit all requests for refunds no later than 10 (ten) calendar days after receiving the corresponding phone bill. The reference date shall be the date given on the said phone bill.

The request for refund shall contain the following items: name and first name of the Entrant, postal address, email address (all of which items must be identical to those entered on the Contest entry form), full bank account details, date and time of entries, and, as soon as it is available, a photocopy of the itemized invoice from the telephone company and or Internet Service Provider itemizing the connection dates (to be underlined). The said photocopy shall serve as proof of residence. The name and address of the person requesting the refund shall be the same as those shown on the telephone company's bill. Article 13: LODGING OF CONTEST RULES

Article 14: INTERPRETATION OF CONTEST RULES

SkyTeam shall answer all queries with respect to the present Contest Rules in compliance with the Dutch law. Its decisions shall be final. Any challenge or claim in connection with the Contest must be set down in writing and sent to the Contest address, and will not be examined until one month after the end of the Contest.

Article 15: APPLICABLE LAW AND JURISDICTION

The present Contest Rules are subject to the Dutch law.

Article 16: ACCEPTANCE OF CONTEST RULES

Entering the present Contest constitutes full and unreserved acceptance of all the clauses and conditions set out in the present Contest Rules.

Article 17: DATA PRIVACY

The Contest is in no way sponsored, endorsed or administered by, or associated with, Facebook. All information provided from the participant is for the use of SkyTeam only and not Facebook.

Personal information gathered as part of the present Contest shall be processed in compliance with the Data Privacy Act. Entrants are hereby informed that information marked with an asterisk on the Contest entry form is required if their entry is to be taken into account.

Pursuant to the Data Privacy Act, all Entrants are entitled to access, modify, and delete any data concerning them.

For all such requests, please apply in writing to begoren@skyteam.com.

Any transfer to third parties of personal data gathered by SkyTeam in the course of the present Contest is subject to prior, express authorization on the part of the Entrant.

Personal information will not be used for any commercial purposes by SkyTeam or any other third party.
